Course Load	Exchange students are expected to register for a minimum of 14 OUEL credits and no more than 26 OUEL credits per semester during their exchange period at OUEL. Students are also advised to check with their home university regarding the requirements on course load while studying abroad.		
Academic Transcript	An original academic transcript will be mailed to the home university within 2 months after the semester ends.		
Sudent withdrawl policy	Students should inform their home university and the home university coordinator informs student's withdrawal to OUEL.		

Visa	
Student Visa	All exchange students must apply for a student visa at your local Japanese consulate/embassy, using the CoE(Visa documents) and a letter of admission. Every student should contact the local consulate/embassy directly to find out what other documents might be necessary. (It is not possible to arrive in Japan on a tourist visa and then change to a student visa.)
Mandatory Insurance	
Overseas Travel Insurance (mandatory)	All exchange students are required to purchase an overseas travel insurance for an entire duration of your study at OUEL before arriving in Japan. The mandatory health insurance you will join after arriving in Japan may not cover all medical cost of a medical treatment you might undergo. Once you receive a data of a granted COE and a letter of admission, please purchase a travel insurance, and then email CIEE a copy of the insurance certificate . You may result in receiving a delayed delivery of the original documents if you fail to submit the certificate copy.
National Health Insurance (mandatory)	All exchange students have to join Japanese National Health Insurance(NHI) after you arrive in Japan. With NHI, students only have to pay 30% of any medical costs occurred at most clinics and hospitals all over Japan. However, the insurance does not fully cover fees for the treatment of injuries that arise from accidents and damages which you may cause to someone else's property or another person. Unexpected situations such as accidents or illnesses may result in an overwhelming financial burden. The students must be with NHI for all months of their stay in Japan. <u>The premium is charged monthly.</u>
Accident Insurance	If you intend to commute by bicycle you are required to have an accident insurance valid for the entire exchange period. Please check out more details at Welcome Orientation Day.

Payment Procedure	Students are required to pay the rent upfront for a whole semester by cash within a month from your arrival.
